



SYLLABUS

Survey of the New Testament: Gospels & Acts

Winter 2005

Course Description

This course is designed as a basic study of the background and message of Matthew, Mark, Luke, John and Acts. Particular attention will be paid to the application of specific truths within each book. Lecture, discussion, and questioning will be included in the class sessions. Homework will include the reading, analyzing, and synthesizing of each book.

Course Objectives

- ❑ Each student will read each book assigned.
- ❑ Each student will complete a simple chart of each book for future study, teaching, etc.
- ❑ Each student will trace a theme through the book of John.
- ❑ Each student will feel more confident in their understanding and use of the gospels and Acts in their own personal lives and in future ministries.

Course Requirements

- ❑ Each student should read each of the New Testament books by the assigned class time.
- ❑ Each student should read any additional readings by the assigned class time.
- ❑ Each student should complete a simple chart for each of the New Testament books assigned, ready to be turned in at class time.
- ❑ Each student will write a short one-page analysis of a selected theme from the book of John.
- ❑ Each student will turn in an “implication for their lives” paper for the course.
