Small Group Questions

5. What are 2-3 reasons why it is important to have a solid, Biblical view of sex? What are the potential repercussions of an inadequate view of sex?
6. Discuss the truth of this statement: "Men are like microwaves and women are like crock pots sexually speaking." How is emotional intimacy connected to sexual intimacy?
